Face prints black type/line matter. Punch one 1/4" diameter hole, 1/4" from left edge, centered on 3-1/8" dimension. Reinforce hole on both sides with a hard fiber patch and metal eyelet, plus a 12" double loop plain string is to be inserted in the eyelet (punch hole). Clip corners at patch end. Tag must be suitable for all temperatures; black colorfast, nonsmear ink.

MATERIAL FURNISHED: Contractor to pickup at GPO. One piece of camera copy and a construction sample for each item.
