DESCRIPTION:

Each item prints numerals in black ink for each month/year as follows: (#1) "12/11"; (#2) "12/12"; (#3) "12/13"; (#4) "12/14"; (#5) "12/15", plus a horizontal rule printing in black ink (follow sample).

After printing, coat the entire face with a suitable UV coating to prevent fading.

Back labels with a permanent type pressure sensitive adhesive and mount on a suitable slit backing sheet. Labels must be theft resistant when attempted to be removed and must withstand extreme temps and humidity changes without discoloring, cracking, becoming brittle or any other deterioration. Products to be used on automobiles.

MATERIAL FURNISHED: Contractor to pickup at GPO. .

One 700MB CDR disk created on a Macintosh computer using Adobe Illustrator CS2 software program.

Files are supplied in Native Format. All fonts are provided on diskette.

One sample from a previous printing for use as a general guide and visual.

Prior to image processing, the contractor is responsible for performing a basic check (preflight) of the furnished publishing files to assure accurate output of the required reproduction image. Any errors, media damage or data corruption that might interfere with proper file imaging must be reported to the contract administrator. Contractor must notify the Government as soon as necessary in order to comply with the shipping schedule.

In addition, the contractor is responsible for creating or altering any necessary trapping, setting proper screen angles and screen frequency, and defining file output selection for the imaging device being utilized.

All furnished files must be imaged as necessary to meet assigned Quality Level.
