### **DESCRIPTION:**

Outside panels and pockets print full coverage with 4 color process illustrations, images and solids built from process colors including text reversing to white. Bleed all sides. Inside panels (after construction) are blank. After printing, coat the entire surface of outside panels and both pockets with a clear, non-yellowing high gloss varnish or lacquer.

Construction: Folded size 9 x 12" with a full depth "V"-cut in pockets. Die cut 4 diagonal slits on right inside pocket suitable for holding 2 standard size business cards. Securely glue 1/2" reinforcement tab foldovers to the inside of folder. Score on all folds.

**MATERIAL FURNISHED:** One CD with disk info sheets and a sample. Make reproduces as necessary. Contractor to remove one type line (Date) from cover 4. See sample.

Electronic media generated on a Macintosh with operating system OSX, using InDesign CS2, Illustrator CS2 and Photoshop CS2. Files are in native format or print-to-file postscript format. All printer and screen fonts are included. Color system used is CMYK or Pantone. Files provide for bleeds and graphics are properly linked

Prior to image processing, the contractor is responsible for performing a basic check (preflight) of the furnished publishing files to assure accurate output of the required reproduction image. Any errors, media damage or data corruption that might interfere with proper file imaging must be reported to the contract administrator in sufficient time to comply with the shipping schedule. In addition, the contractor is responsible for creating or altering any necessary trapping, setting proper screen angles and screen frequency, and defining file output selection for the imaging device being utilized. All furnished files must be imaged as necessary to meet assigned quality level.
